**Ash Wednesday:** We have received instructions from the office of Bishop Wack for the distribution of ashes on Ash Wednesday 2021. They are:

The celebrant blesses the ashes as usual using the formula in the *Roman Missal*.

1. The celebrant sprinkles the ashes with holy water, without saying anything.
2. The celebrant, from the sanctuary, says one of the formulae for the imposition of ashes ("Repent, and believe ..." or "Remember that you are dust ...") **one time only**, loudly so that all can hear. It would also be appropriate to invite the faithful to kneel for this, as a sign of repentance.
3. The celebrant (along with any assisting him) sanitizes his hands, puts on a facemask.
4. **Two options:**
  - a. The minister may sprinkle a small amount (a "pinch") of the ashes on the head of each person **without saying anything**.
  - b. **Or** - He may use a Q-tip or something similar to make a cross with ashes on each forehead, **also without saying anything**.
