Upcoming Things to Note:

- All Saints Day on Friday, November 1, **is a Holy Day of Obligation in 2024.** The Vigil Mass is Thursday October 31 at 6:00 pm and Mass on Friday November 1 at 8:00 am.
- We will have an 8:00 am Mass on Saturday, November 2, to Commemorate All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day).
- Daylight Savings Time ends on Sunday, November 3, at 2:00 am. Please remember to change your clocks by turning them back 1 hour before you go to sleep – “Fall backwards”
